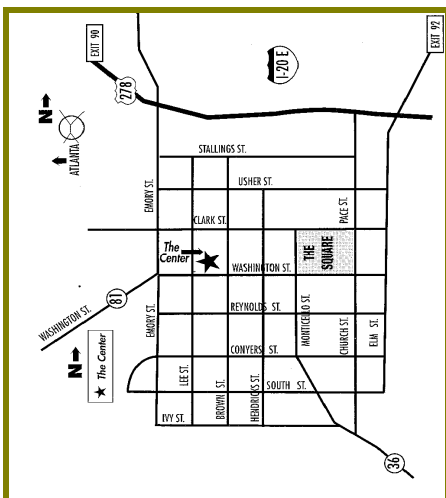
The Center is a nonprofit organization dedicated to creating and maintaining a neutral environment where all citizens of Newton County and the surrounding region may gather to understand and manage issues associated with dramatic growth and development.



The Center's studio-style **Main Room** is 48'X30' with a 17' ceiling, motorized roll-down viewing screen, Internet access, and audio system. For a fee additional to the room rental, a laptop and LCD projector are available as well. Permanent displays on transportation, land use, the environment, political and census districts, and demographics adorn the walls and tell the story of growth in Newton County and the region.

The **Main Room** will hold up to 200 people for a reception. The Center has chairs for 70 people classroom-style or 32 people conference style. There is also a pre-function area well suited for group registrations or buffets.

The **Conference Room** will accommodate 15 people.



Facility Fees

Main Room: \$50/hour up to \$350
Non-refundable reservation deposit: \$50
Cleaning charge for events with food: \$50
Laptop and LCD projector: \$30/hour
Conference Room: \$30/hour

Directions from Atlanta: Take Interstate 20 East to Exit 90 (Covington/Oxford; Hwy. 278). Merge onto Hwy. 278 East. At the second traffic light, Hwy. 81/Emory Street, turn right. Again at the second traffic light, Washington Street, turn left. The Center is one block up on the left, adjacent to the Chamber of Commerce.
